She is Mechanical Engineer and at the beginning of her career she had worked in the mining industry of coal, in Jiu Valley. After her master degree in Environmental Sciences she worked for a while in research institute in Jiu Valley. She was implied as researcher in some project about reduction of the environmental pollution, environmental rehabilitation, waste reusing and recycling, and environmental risks and also in projects that aimed to strengthen the links between the academia and the business environment.
