Giovanna D'Inverno, PhD, is Tenure-track Assistant Professor in Mathematical Methods for Economics, Actuarial Science and Finance at the Department of Economics and Management, University of Pisa (Italy). She has a joint PhD degree (2018) from Scuola IMT Alti Studi Lucca (Italy) and KU Leuven (Belgium), a postdoc at KU Leuven in the Leuven Economics of Education Research center and a flourishing academic career in the field of quantitative methods and public economics, with publications in top-ranked journals.
